Inefficiencies, heavyweight, carrying limitations and the risk of damage render the experience difficult and unpleasant.

The newest additions to the Explorer Cases line are designed to solve these problems, keeping the travelling professional in mind: with the highest degree of portability, lightweight, volume efficiency and, most importantly, the ruggedness and protection for which Explorer Cases is well known for.



Comfort and lightweight are key for any long journey, and airline travel is no exception. The Explorer Cases 5221 and 5218 are some of the lightest waterproof carry-on protective hard cases on the market.

To achieve some of the highest standard of protection the gasket sealing plays a key role; Explorer Cases utilizes a proprietary technology for coinjecting polyurethane without joining points, which is deposited without the use of any glue. This high quality manufacturing process provides reliable protection to the contents of the case, even in the highest and lowest temperatures, for many years.

The new Explorer Cases 5221 fits and complies with the strict IATA regulations, while the 5218 model features a slightly shallower lid, to accommodate the less spacious overhead compartments of low-cost airlines. A thorough analysis of airline's guidelines and limitations on size and weight of carry-on bags has led to a much higher volumetric efficiency.

For a more comfortable carrying experience and for enhanced transportability the Cabin Hard Cases feature a rubber over-molded grip handle on the side, an extractable handle and self-oiling free running wheels.

The Explorer Cases 5221 and 5218 are the cases for



protecting your valuable equipment without compromising comfort and efficiency.



The development of new technological polymer compounds allowed to achieve a lighter weight without compromising protective performance and waterproofness.

This technological improvement provides flexibility and resiliency upon mechanical stress and impact within an overall more efficient package; this has led to the launch of the “Heavenly Light Cases” line by Explorer Cases.

The 5221 Cabin Case internally measures 520 x 285 x 205 mm and weighs 3.90 Kg empty.

The proprietary gasket manufacturing process ensures waterproofness longevity even in hot e cold environments.

The case features two new generation latches that secure the seal and are practical for opening. The new latch is provided with an inherent safety feature, without the use of metallic springs, which could cause problems after long exposures in maritime and humid environments.



The new latch’s dual-stage opening allows to distribute the force needed for the opening action in two segments of its path, providing a security while maintain ease of opening.



Two stainless steel reinforced lockable points ensure a secure transport, with the Explorer Cases TSA compliant four-digit lock.

The Explorer Cases 5221 Cabin Luggage is available in three colors: Black, Desert Sand and Military Green in the three variants: with internal padded dividers, with foam and empty.



The Explorer Cases 5218 cabin luggage is designed to be fully compliant with low-cost airlines policies; in fact, it is the only waterproof hard case currently on the market that is within the very strict Ryanair luggage limitations.

The only differences between the two models are the lid dimensions and furniture. Due to the shallower depth, it is not possible to mount the same lid sleeve and pouches of the 5221. Except these two differences, there are no compromises in either protection or waterproofness. Both cases surpass rigorous Military Standards.



The 5218 Cabin Case internally measures 520 x 285 x 18 mm and weighs 3.75 Kg empty.
