REACH compliance declaration for products supplied by Shell Case Ltd.

- Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH) is the Regulation on Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals. It entered into force on 1st June 2007. It streamlines and improves the former legislative framework on chemicals of the European Union (EU).
- The main aims of REACH are to ensure a high level of protection of human health and the environment from the risks that can be posed by chemicals, the promotion of alternative test methods, the free circulation of substances on the internal market and enhancing competitiveness and innovation.
- Shell Case Ltd supports the objective of REACH to further improve the European Union's regulation on chemicals, including the aim to advance public health and safety and to protect the environment.
- We have requested all our material, components or finished products suppliers to deliver us only REACH compliance items and further to provide us information on the relevant chemicals in their supplied products. This enables us to provide our customers with information about designated substances of very high concern (SVHC), as required by article 33 of REACH (if those are present in a concentration of more than 0.1% of the weight of a product).
- Based on our internal assessment using available guidance and statements from our suppliers, we believe that all our products comply with REACH regulation and none of our products contain substances that are intended to be released under normal and reasonable use but we do not confirm that by any third party or external testing
- If a formal REACH compliance certification is required for any specific item, it should be done after testing by specialized laboratory that is certified to perform that type of chemicals evaluation.
