EU RoHS 3 compliance declaration for products supplied by Shell Case Ltd.

- Shell case Limited declares that, to the best of our knowledge, products produced by the company are in compliance with Directive (EU) 2015/863 amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (also known as “RoHS Recast”).
- Products manufactured should not contain the substances listed in the table below in concentrations greater than the listed maximum value.

Lead (Pb)	0.1%
Mercury (Hg)	0.1%
Cadmium (Cd)	0.01%
Hexavalent Chromium (Cr6+)	0.1%
Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB)	0.1%
Polybrominated Diphenyl ethers (PBDE)	0.1%
Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)	0.1%
Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)	0.1%
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	0.1%
Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	0.1%

- Based on our internal assessment using available guidance and statements from our suppliers, we believe that all our products comply with RoHS 3 regulation and none of our products contain substances that are intended to be released under normal and reasonable use but we do not confirm that by any third party or external testing
- If a formal RoHS compliance certification is required for any specific item, it should be done after testing by specialized laboratory that is certified to perform that type of chemicals evaluation.
